

The Spring Tuesday Night Marathon

March 14th – May 2nd, 2017.

- 8 rounds, one game every Tuesday.
- Round 1: 6:30 p.m. March 14th.
Round 2: March 21st. Round 3: March 28th. Round 4: April 4th. Round 5: April 11th. Round 6: April 18th.
Round 7: April 25th. Round 8: May 2nd.
- Time Control: G/2,d5. There will be no adjournments.
- All time delay must be from the beginning.
- Entry Fee: \$50.00. \$60.00 for registration on the day of the first round.
- Prizes: 60% of the prize fund given to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Overall; Best Under 2200, Under 2000, Under 1800, Under 1600, Under 1400, Under 1200, and Unrated. All lower-rated players are eligible to win higher class prizes.
- Cash prizes can only be given to Mechanics' Institute members. All other prizes will be given as either a membership to the Mechanics' Institute plus the remainder in cash, or partial payment toward a year's membership, the balance of which must be paid within 30 days or forfeited.
- The tournament will follow USCF rules and all players must be current members of the USCF through the end of May 2017.
- The tournament will be FIDE-rated.
- A request for up to three 1/2 point byes will be accepted under the following conditions:
 1. All byes are irrevocable.
 2. No byes may be requested for rounds seven and eight.
 3. Bye requests must be made by noon on Monday for the following Tuesday night round.
- Normally, pairings will be made Monday noon and will be posted online and in the Chess Room.
